

10 TIPS FOR A STRESS FREE WEDDING DAY

EASY STEPS FROM THE EXPERTS



1. Make a Priority list

From 1-10, Most Important to Least.

Get the BIG 3 out of the way first!
Usually Wedding Date, Venue,
Photographer/Videographer. Put your energy
and focus into the most important must haves
and let the other things come as they may.



2. DON'T TRY AND PLEASE EVERYONE.

6 months-1 year at least!

off and get it done!



4. DETAILED WEDDING TIMELINE

Build in gaps & breaks & stick to it.

Stress usually comes when you're trying to
squeeze everything into a small time-slot.
Breaks help you move the day along in case
something comes up. Always have breaks in
between events.

5. HIRE EXPERIENCED VENDORS

Trust them to do their job.



Follow up with vendors and show them your
vision. Make sure there is a contract, and that
they are licensed, insured. Rarely is it a good
idea to hire family members to help cover
something on the wedding, let them enjoy the
wedding and leave the professionals to handle
the festivities and events.

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
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6. VENDORS ARRIVE EARLY

Time should be given to set up!

If things are being set up last minute, it will always cause stress for you, vendors, guests. Always allow extra time for professionals to show up early and create the magic for you!



7. TRUST MULTIPLE RECOMMENDATIONS

From friends/family, other vendors

If you hear good things from a close friend about a florist, DJ, venue, photographer, check up on it and trust that they are going to do a fantastic job for you too. Always do research!



8. MAKE ALL PAYMENTS IN FULL BEFORE THE DAY.

This is common sense.

You want to make sure all vendors are paid in full before the day. This alleviates vendors trying to find you to get paid on the day, and instead they are able to focus on you and doing a fantastic job and you don't have to worry about it.



9. HIRE A PLANNER

Leave the stress to someone else!

We really can't emphasize this one enough. Research and really get to know their client experience before hiring one. They work with you to get exactly what you want for the budget that you have. Planners are passionate about making it a perfect day and they do all the stressing for you. They are the ones who have all the connections and can make your dreams come true.
